



## President's Message

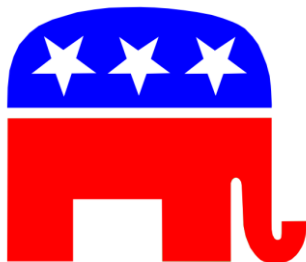
