
Please join me, and the growing numbers of ARW members, to continue working diligently in making sure we, the Republicans, take our Country back!

As we reviewed the news for things of interest to write about this month, we clearly saw that nothing much is going on in the legislative world. The Texas Legislature is not in session, and the federal government, embroiled in election year chaos, appears to be getting very little accomplished. Indeed, among the Top 10 most reviewed pieces of legislation from last week, this resolution shows how very little our elected officials are accomplishing:

#### IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

MARCH 14, 2016

Mr. SESSIONS (for himself, Mr. STIVERS, Mr. MEEHAN, Mr. DONOVAN, Mr.

DENT, Mr. SIMPSON, and Mr. BUCK) submitted the following resolution;

which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform
