LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Wow! If this election were a Hollywood script playing out on the screen, no one would believe it. The past couple of weeks of this election cycle have been crazy. With all the recent revelations about Clinton's email scandal, and with legislators making their final bid for constituents' votes, it's no wonder that nothing much is getting done in Washington. We look forward to the beginning of the 2017 Texas Legislative session in January, so we have something to report!

With that said, here's a piece of legislation, proposed by local Congressman Bill Flores, that affects all of us at the gas pump and beyond. It's no secret that the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has abused its power through overreaching federal regulations over the past eight years. One of the EPA's more harmful regulations is known as the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS). The RFS forces more ethanol into the market than it can handle thereby increasing food and fuel costs on us all. These increased ethanol levels also damage small engines as well as recreational vehicle and older vehicle engines. Indeed, studies suggest that the RFS may actually cause higher emissions that negatively impact the environment more than conventional fuels. So, Congressman Flores introduced the *Food and Fuel Consumer Protection Act* to limit the negative impacts of the RFS on hardworking American families. The bill limits the RFS mandate by capping the maximum volume of ethanol blended into the transportation fuel supply to a level that our nation's cars, trucks, boats, and other small engines can safely accommodate. The bill remains pending in the House Energy and Power Subcommittee. Make sure that this common sense, money-saving legislation passes by contacting your representatives (use the link below) and letting them know that you are watching.
